
Figure 1. Total Number of Unintentional Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.







Figure 2. Number of Heroin-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.






Figure 3. Number of Prescription Opioid-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.





Figure 4. Number of Fentanyl-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.






Figure 5. Number of Cocaine-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.




Figure 6. Number of Benzodiazepine-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.




Figure 7. Number of Alcohol-Related Intoxication Deaths, Maryland.


