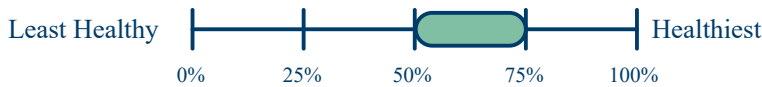

Health Outcomes tell us how long people live on average within a community, and how much physical and mental health people experience in a community while they are alive.

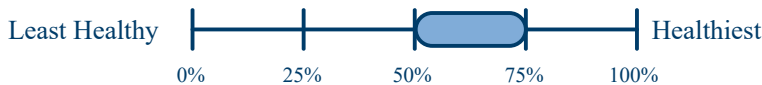
Talbot (TA) is ranked in the higher middle range of counties in Maryland (Higher 50%-75%).

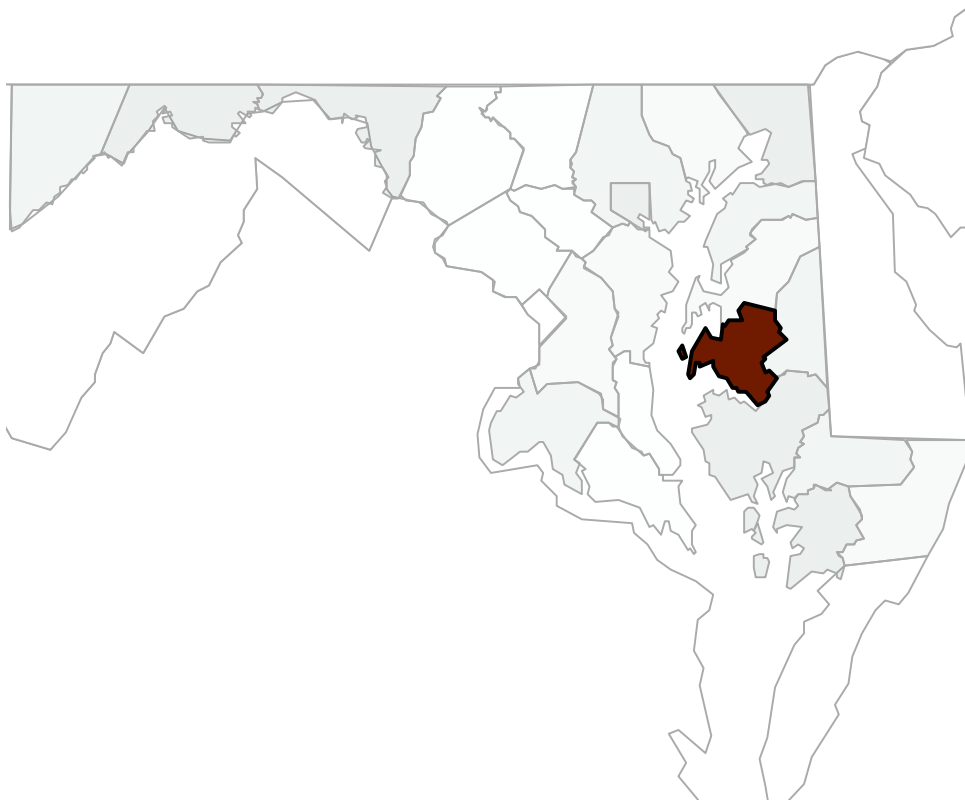


### Health Factors

Talbot County, Maryland is Micropolitan (intersecting an urban core of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 population). In Talbot County, 54.7% of the population lives in a low population density area (500 or fewer people per square mile and less than 2,500 people).
